Recreational Activities Coordinator (2)

Candidates for the Recreational Activities Coordinator position will oversee all of our children's activities and family events within the church and in the community. Flexibility and creativity will be needed to engage the multicultural and multigenerational groups in each program. This position requires the Recreational Activities Coordinator to plan, set up and run these activities, oversee volunteers, as well as implement advertising and promotions of these programs. This position develops and promotes leadership abilities, strength in organization and working in a team environment with volunteers, staff and the Children's Ministry Director.

Youth Recreational Coordinator (2)

Our Youth Interns will work together with our Youth Pastor and Children's Ministries Director to create connections for children and youth in a safe and caring environment. Programs will be offered within our facility, as well as community outreach for kids and youth in the Coquitlam and Port Coquitlam area. Connection and activities will happen during the week as well as on Sunday mornings. With all events planned, the candidates will work with a demographic of multicultural children and youth. This position requires the Youth Interns to plan and promote youth programs, prepare schedules, communicate with the team, work with volunteers, and coordinate activities. They will also support and work in conjunction with the Recreation Activities Coordinators and their programs. This employment develops and promotes leadership abilities such as reliability, decision making, problem solving, self-motivation, organizational skills, and working in a team environment with volunteers, staff, Youth Pastor, and Children's Ministry Director.

Pastoral Intern (1)

The Pastoral Intern will work with our pastoral team to experience and partner with the tasks and assignments associated with the daily operation of the church. This may include, but is not limited to, working in our Worship department, Youth department, Children's Ministries department, and community outreach. This position will also include opportunities to assist in various aspects of Sunday morning services, attend council meetings to understand the financial and organizational running of the church, shadow and assist with weddings and funerals. This will provide the opportunity to teach how compassion and empathy is needed to care for individuals and families. Honesty and integrity are highly valued and expected in this position. This candidate will learn the importance of listening to and communicating effectively with others, understanding that everyone is valued and important.
